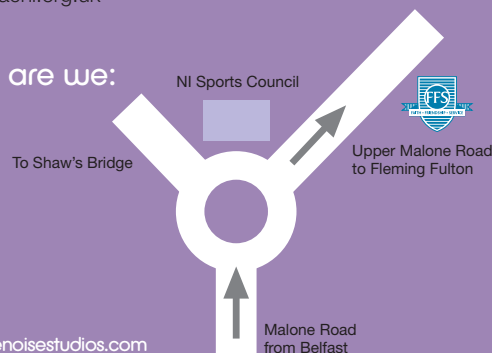

Fleming Fulton School have established their own support and advice centre for young people (aged 2-19) with physical disabilities and associated learning needs.

Our aim is to facilitate the inclusion of these young people in the school of their choice.

The LILAC team consists of a Teacher (Inclusion Coordinator), Occupational Therapist, Classroom Assistant and IT technician.

This service is available free of charge to all schools in Northern Ireland.

Supporting the young person

Ensuring the young persons voice is central when identifying needs.

Developing inclusive social and extra-curricular activities.

Disability awareness/inclusive practice.

Supporting the school

Training for teachers, classroom assistants and other staff to support inclusion.
